DR. HEATHER GRAY PROVIDING FREE EYE EXAMS FOR SERVICE DOGS THROUGHOUT THE MONTH OF MAY

Dr. Heather Gray will be participating in the ACVO's National Service-Dog Eye Exam event throughout the month of May.



Dr. Gray will be among the 140 board-certified veterinary ophthalmologists across North America providing free sight-saving eye exams and preventive health reports for 5,000 to 10,000 service dogs. These Service Dog groups include: guide dogs, handicapped assistance dogs, detection dogs, and search and rescue dogs. In order to qualify dogs must be active 'working dogs' that have been certified by a formal training program or organization or currently enrolled in a formal training program. All dogs must have certification and/or training paperwork to prove their status as a working Service Dog in order to participate in this year's program.
